During the Holy Week, we spent time reflecting upon events unfolding Jesus's journey from "Hosanna in the highest" to "Crucifixion". We reflected upon confrontations between Jesus and religious leaders. We visualized how Jesus cleared the temple court of traders and heard how he countered questions from Chief Priests and elders about his authority. We reflected on our own faith journeys during the Holy Week.





The Department of Social & Human Development restarted all its activities and Programmes at all the 5 Community Development Centers which were withheld for a period of 2 years due to pandemic COVID-19. The Five Community Development Centers with 17 Alternative Learning Centers 101 Activities are started on 1st April 2022. The main highlight of the activities started at Community Development Centers are the 03 Day Care Centers and 20 Balwadis to support Early Childhood Care for children in the age group of 1to 5 Years and supportive parental care. Parents feel happy to send their children back to YMCA Community Development Centers and the children were very excited.

The Department of Social and Human Development, Family Counselling Centre Sunlight Colony in coordination with Delhi Social Welfare Board NCT of Delhi, Saheli Samanvay Kendra (SSK) Organized sessions with Community Women, Aganwadi Supervisor & Workers of North –East Zone of Delhi on the Role of Women in the family to support the growth and development of adolescent children in the family and Domestic Violence Act.

The AGP on the Role of Women in the family to support the Growth and Development of Adolescent Children in the Family was organized on 8th April 2022. The objective of the session was to aware Women of their role with their Adolescent Children and how to assist in behavioral change, enhance coping skills, promote decision making, and improve the relationship. 21 women participated in the program. The AGP on Domestic Violence Act was organized on for 12th April 2022 The objective of the session was to educate the Women on the Domestic Violence Act and the importance of the ACT for empowering the Women to know their legal right to benefit themselves and their Children if they sometimes in life fall to any kind of Domestic Violence. 14 women participated in the program.

YMCA Public School Nizamuddin - Kindergarten Graduation Day




