HPDP Staff Training Programme

An HPDP Staff training programme in Social & Behavioural Skills was held on 27.04.2022 at Heinz Auditorium, New Delhi YMCA. The aim of the training was to hone the skills of HPDP employees and to enhance their efficiency. 26 HPDP Staff Members including Office Assistants, Asstt. Librarian, Faculty Members of IOM & IMSIT, JPOs, JTO, Directors of all Institutes, Executive Director HPDP and Senior Secretary HPDP, attended this training programme successfully. The session was a blended programme of a few activities and the practical aspect was 2.5 Hours which included a few activities and the theoretical aspect of the above-mentioned programme. The Programme began with a welcoming address by Ms. Meenakshi Gupta, Executive Director – HPDP. It was inaugurated by the Hon'ble GS & CEO, New Delhi YMCA Mr. Mark Clive. In his address, he advised the HPDP staff members to upgrade their skills in their respective duty areas. He further mentioned the staff members to be more proactive. He emphasized being more specific in the communication.

Dr. Anjali Gupta and Ms. Tapobraty Das, Guest Faculty Members of IMS & IMSIT respectively, were the resource persons for the training. The session was started with an activity related to Team Work. In the training, it was emphasized to enhance interpersonal relationships, effective communication, engaging attitude and to have productive emotions. In engaging attitude, the three factors: job satisfaction, job involvement and commitment were discussed. Further to it, the resource persons focused on self-awareness, self-management, social awareness and responsible decision making.

The delegates were satisfied by the session. The learning outcomes of trainees have mentioned in their feedback forms are: how to respond well, holistic development of personality, listening skills, following protocols, fundamentals of speech, team building, how to grow together, and how to get more win-win situations. The outcome of the training session was good and all the participants demanded more such similar pieces of training in future regularly. The delegates also learnt the importance of understanding others' reasoning, adaptability to change, team building and avoiding begrudging. The session was concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Ms. Meenakshi Gupta, Executive Director –HPDP. The training session was followed by lunch in the Dining Hall, Tourist Hostel, NDY.
