Institute of Civil Services (ICS)

The Institute of Civil Services was set up in 1972, with the objective of imparting practical instruction and guidance to young men and women seeking entry into the Public Servies in India. The first Director of the Institute was Dr. S. Gupta. In 1973 the Institute produced amazing results by securing the 2nd and 6th positions in IFS, 2nd and 5th positions in IAS, and 6th and 7th positions in IPS. In that year 8 were selected for IAS, 7 for IFS, 17 for IPS and 25 for Allied services.
