YMCA Lebanon office damaged

A massive explosion ripped through central Beirut, near the city's port on Tuesday, 4 August. The blast sent up a huge mushroom cloud-shaped shockwave, flipped cars and damaged distant buildings.

Four of the city's hospitals were damaged by the explosion and are out of service. The YMCA Lebanon office also suffered damages. All the windows of the office were blown apart. Fortunately the office was empty as the explosion happened after working hours. "All our staff and volunteers are safe" shares Mr Issam Bishara, CEO of YMCA Lebanon. "But we are all in shock. We have never faced such a terrible situation in our lives." New Delhi YMCA prays for the safety and wellbeing of the YMCA Lebanon.

Carlos Sanvee, Secretary General World YMCA, expressed solidarity: "Our thoughts and prayers are with our friends in Beirut and across Lebanon, who are impacted by this terrible explosion. We stand with you in solidarity as you recover and rebuild." Messages of prayer and support have also been shared from the YMCA family from around the globe.
